Instructions

Project #1026

- Step 1:** On natural paper stamp the word freedom, script and postage art using black ink. Stamp fern using green ink.
- Step 2:** Cut out postage art and color with pencils. Cut out fern.
- Step 3:** Tear edges of script, freedom and black natural paper slightly larger than postage stamp. Burnish with black and green ink.
- Step 4:** Glue postage art onto torn paper.
- Step 5:** Punch hole at bottom center of torn paper and upper right corner of script.
- Step 6:** Using 28 gauge wire and wire worker, make a 1" coil. Stretch coil and secure to hole on torn paper. Using a 2" piece of wire, add three beads and secure to hole on torn paper.
- Step 7:** Using pliers loop end of 20 gauge wire and spiral and wiggle wire to approximately 2" in length. Thread seed beads onto 28-gauge wire and secure to wiggle. Attach wiggle to script paper with 28-gauge wire.
- Step 8:** Attach foam squares to backs of step #4 and freedom. Attach to script.
- Step 9:** Using tape, attach fern to script paper then attach stamped design to black card stock.
