24 gauge

Lemon (1 spool)

Artistic Wire™ - Tools

Wire Worker

Basic Supplies/Tools

Bead Crimping Tool
Barrow Clasp - 1 each
Crimp Beads - 2 each
Small Brass Beads - 22 each
Small Glass Rondelles - 14 Rust and 14 Aqua
Small Ceramic Tube Beads - 10 each Rust
Medium Glass Beads - 4 Aqua and 4 Gold
Large Beads - 2 Gold and 2 Amber
Extra Large Pendant - Amber.
Metal Cones - 18 each in Brass.
Brass coils, *made with the Wire Worker* - 14 each

Instructions

Note - *Wire Lengths Will Vary Depending On The Size Of Your Beads.*

- Step 1) Using the smallest metal dowel with the wire worker, and the 24- gauge Brass wire, make 14 coils, 3/8 inch long. Set aside.
- Step 2) Cut 6 pieces of 24-gauge brass wire 6- inches long. Cut 6 pieces of the 24-gauge lemon wire 4- inches long. Lay 3 pieces of the 6- inch long wire side by side, take 1 of the 4- inch pieces of lemon wire and wrap around the wires forming a small coil, not to tight. Make 3 small coils for each set of 3 wires. See photo. Repeat on second set of 6-inch long wires and set aside.
- Step 3) Cut 3 pieces of 24-gauge brass wire 14- inches long. Cut 5 pieces of 24-gauge lemon wire 4- inches long. Repeat the process as in step # 2 making and placing 5 coils to fit the large pendent. Set aside.
- Step 4) Using the 6-inch wires from step # 2. spread the outer wires leaving the center wire straight. Insert one of the large beads into the center, and wrap the wires around the bead, twisting all the wires together at the top of the bead. See photo. Repeat this process on the second large bead.
- Step 5) Repeat the process in step # 4. Using the pendent and the 14-inch long 24- gauge brass wire sets from step # 3. Trim the wire ends and make a small swirl at the top of each wire, including the 2 large wired beads from step # 4. See photo. Set aside.
- Step 6) Make a lay out with your beads and coils in the order that you will be stringing them. If you do not have a bead buddy you can use a towel so they will not roll out of position.
- Step 7) Cut 1 piece of 24-gauge brass wire 30-inches long. Attach one side of the barrow clasp to one end of the wire. Using 1 crimp bead and the crimping tool; crimp the bead attaching the clasp to the wire. Start stringing the beads and coils from the opposite end of the wire. Attach the second half of the barrow clasp with the remaining crimp bead. Be sure to feed the wire through the last bead strong as well. Trim excess wire.

Note - *The large beads in this necklace are approximately 1 inch in diameter, on the flat side. The pendent is 3 inches long. Remember to adjust your wire lengths accordingly...*
