24 & 26 Gauge: Non-Tarnish Silver

Instructions

Project #1030

- Step 1: Crop photos as desired and double mat with Turquoise and Silver paper.
- Step 2: Using the Wire Worker and the smallest metal mandrel, twist piece of Silver wire approximately 3-4".
- Step 3: Stretch this piece out, leaving some of the waves in the wire.
- Step 4: Place the stretched piece between WacketDown (or between flat items that will not scratch the wire) & flatten completely.
- Step 5: Cut desired number of large Balloons with die cut or use a template. Adhere to page.
- Step 6: Cut stretched wire strings to desired lengths
- Step 7: Attach wire balloon strings by making tiny holes with needle tool (place on foam cushion to do this) approximately 1" apart. Make 1/2" "U" shapes with 26 gauge silver wire. Insert these "U" shapes through the tiny holes around wire string and secure by making a loop at the back of the page with round nose pliers.
- Step 8: Use 24 gauge Silver wire to make balloon bow. Follow diagram for Jewelry Jig, using the 3/8" pegs. Leave a 1" tail to begin, then wrap wire in a figure 8 three times, leaving a tail on the other end. Remove from Jewelry Jig and wrap center with additional wire.
- Step 9: Adhere matted photos to page.
- Step 10: Use additional wavy wire to embellish outside of photos, attaching to the page as above.
