### Materials Check List

*Artistic Wire™*  
10 gauge, Tinned Copper  
(*approx. 10 ft.*)  
18 gauge, Tinned Copper  
(*1 spool*)

*Artistic Wire™-Tools*  
Round Nose Pliers (*optional*)

*Basic Supplies/Tools*  
Large Wire Cutter  
3/4" Large Dowel or  
Handle of Wire Whisk

### Instructions

### Project #104

Step 1: Cut 7 pieces of 10 gauge tinned copper wire, each 12" long.

Step 2: Take each 12" piece of wire, wrap 4" around dowel to create 1 1/2" circles, making sure that wire is taut with each turn. Complete circles should be close to each other.

Step 3: Make a coil similar in diameter to a bangle using approximately 26" of 10 ga. tinned copper wire. Randomly spread out coils slightly from one another. This will serve as the base holder for your card holders.

Step 4: Randomly attach card holders to coil using 18 ga. wire, making sure to keep placement of card holders evenly to disperse weight.

Step 5: Bend card holders in different directions to create style.
