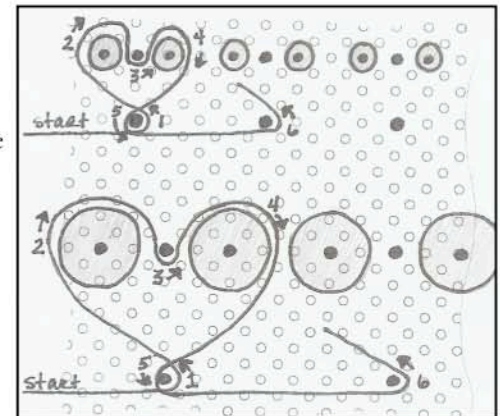

Instructions

- Step 1:* If mache box is not already white or cream, paint with White acrylic paint.
- Step 2:* Cut mulberry paper to fit the lid of the box, plus a little extra to fold to outside edge. Glue on top of lid with glue stick.
- Step 3:* Cut mulberry paper to fit the sides of the box base, plus 1/2" to fold to inside and bottom of box. Glue mulberry paper with glue stick.
- Step 4:* Cut poster board the following sizes: a strip the width of top lip to wrap around outside of box lid, a strip to fit inside wall of the box bottom, a circle slightly smaller than the bottom of the box.
- Step 5:* Cut mulberry paper the same length as each piece of poster board, plus 1/2" to fold over to wrong sides. Glue each of these mulberry pieces onto poster board with glue stick.
- Step 6:* Stamp "Candy Box" five times using Red Mica ink on white cardstock. When dry, cut out around outside edges. Use sponge applicator to apply Pink ink to ribbon/bow portion of candy box. Apply Glossy Accents to the pink portion and allow to dry completely. Attach foam tape to the back of each Candy Box.
- Step 7:* Using 20 gauge red wire, make small heart border pattern to fit lid strip (following pattern). You will need to continuously remove the wire hearts from the jig & shift down until you have enough to fit around the lid strip.
- Step 8:* Attach wire heart border to strip by making tiny holes with needle tool or push pin (place on foam cushion to do this) on top and bottom of heart (do one heart at a time).
- Step 9:* To attach, make 1" horseshoe shapes with 26 gauge wire. Insert these horseshoe shapes through the tiny holes and secure by flattening on the back of the cardstock or box.
- Step 10:* Follow same procedure to make large heart border and attach to base of box.
- Step 11:* Glue wired strip to lip of top with Tacky Glue, securing with clothespins until dry.
- Step 12:* Glue covered poster circle to bottom of box, and strip (to cover wire staples) to inside of box with Tacky Glue, securing with clothespins until dry.
- Step 13:* Adhere stamped Candy Boxes to the top of the box.
