Materials Check List

Artistic Wire™
22 & 26 Gauge Red

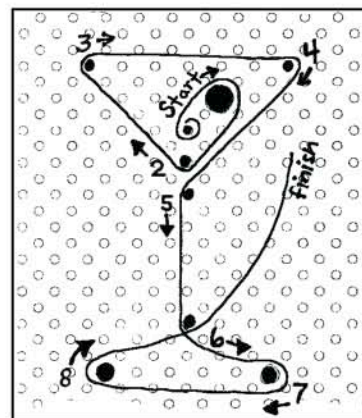
Artistic Wire™-Tools
Jewelry Jig
Nylon Jaw Pliers
Round Nose Pliers
Wire Cutters

Basic Supplies/Tools
Crystal Rhinestones
Needle Tool or pin
Small Piece of Fun Foam or Other Cushion
Gem Adhesive

Instructions

Project #1056

- Step 1:* Use the Jewelry Jig and follow the pattern to set up the pegs. Cut piece of 22 gauge wire 14" long. Follow the pattern starting with a loop in the olive (made with round nose pliers, large enough for rhinestone).
- Step 2:* Once you have finished wrapping around the last peg of the base of the glass, twist excess wire around the stem of the glass and cut off excess wire.
- Step 3:* To attach the wire martini glass to cardstock, make tiny holes with needle tool or pin (place on foam cushion to do this) in several places on both sides of the wire that you want to secure. Make 1/2" horseshoe shapes with 26 gauge matching wire. Insert these horseshoe shapes through the tiny holes around glass and secure by flattening open on the back of the cardstock (like a brad).
- Step 4:* Glue a rhinestone in the starting loop in the olive and allow to dry.
