Instructions

- Step 1:* Prepare wood frame as desired and spray all sides with Black Primer, following manufacturer's instructions.
- Step 2:* Spray primed frame with Black Glossy Paint, following manufacturer's instructions.
- Step 3:* When frame is completely dry, stamp with White Pigment Ink and emboss with White Embossing powder.
- Step 4:* Apply Super Tape to the back of the frame (this will hold the wire in place while wrapping).
- Step 5:* Wrap White wire around the frame, going in all directions. Straighten wire with Nylon Jaw Pliers if necessary. Continue wrapping until desired look is achieved. You may need to cut wire as you wrap to make it more manageable.
- Step 6:* Make spiders out of desired color 22 gauge wire. For each spider, start by making a small swirl with round nose pliers and continue with nylon jaw pliers. Cut four 1” pieces for each spider and glue to back side of swirl with Metal Glue. When glue is dry, bend legs to desired position, then apply more glue and adhere to frame.
- Step 7:* With Tacky Glue, adhere black felt to the back of frame to cover tape and wire.
