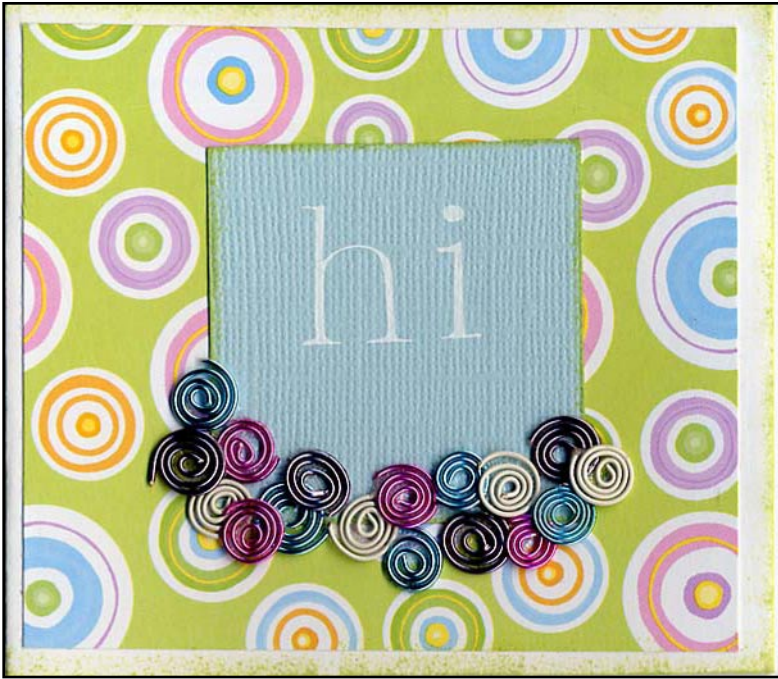


Hi Card

Materials for Card

Artistic Wire™

22 Gauge;

Egg White, Amethyst, Ice Blue & Rose
or Wire swirls – Assorted Colors

Artistic Wire™ Tools

Wire Cutter

Nylon Jaw Pliers

Round Nose Pliers

Basic Supplies/Tools

Cardstock;

Bazzill Basics: Jetstream

Worldwind: ColorMates – Light Heritage White

PaperFever: Pastel Ring-A-Ding

ColorBox: Lime Pastel Fluid Chalk

Making Memories: Simply Stated Rub-on Letters- evolution

ThermOWeb: Zots Clear Adhesive Dots

Instructions

Cut and Assemble Card as follows:

Light Heritage White:

1. Cut one 3 ½" x 12" white.
2. Score and fold every 4 inches – making two folds to form a card with the front being doubled over (a tri-fold).
3. Ink around edges with Lime Pastel chalk ink
4. Set aside

Ring-A-Ding:

1. Cut one 3 ¼ x 3 ¾" piece, adhere to top of card leaving small margin around edges.

Jetstream Blue:

1. Cut one 2" x 2".
2. Ink edges with Lime Pastel chalk ink.
3. Adhere to card in center.

Shape Swirls:

1. Using 22 gauge egg white, amethyst, rose and ice blue wire, cut with your wire cutter, four or five 3" sections of wire from each color. Make a tight curl at one end of your wire with the round nose pliers. Place the curl between your thumb and index finger and move curl in a clockwise motion to form a tight swirl. You can also use nylon jaw pliers to hold your wire and guide it into a swirl. Attach swirls in a random pattern with ZOTS clear adhesive dots grouping them at the bottom of your Jetstream Blue square.

Greeting:

1. Use rub-on letters for card greeting "hi". You can also use alphabet stamps for greeting.
